As a result of the continuing and varying restrictions throughout this season, the Branch have delivered all presentations via webinars, which have been extremely well supported thus ensuring a successful season.

The one exception from a purely webinar event was the meeting on the HQS Wellington on 4th April which was delivered as a hybrid event.

Since the last AGM there have been nine (9) events. Details of all the presentations delivered are included in this report which will be posted to the London Branch website. The webinars were well attended with an average of 52 attendees, the most being 123 attendees. This number continues to be greater than past averages and indicates that webinars are very well received. Council will consider this increase in attendance and popularity of webinars going forward when the 2022/2023 program is developed, and attempt to provide in-person events, webinars, and hybrid events as appropriate.
