Undocking HMS Prince of Wales - New Ship Challenges

This presentation will aim to give an overview of the preparation leading to the undocking, extraction and berthing of HMS Prince of Wales at Rosyth in December 2017. It will detail the steps required to safely achieve this complex evolution on time by focusing on three key areas:

- establishing the condition of the ship
- control and monitoring the vessel's attitude
- management of the entire operation

The presentation will look at the effect of differences from the undocking of HMS Queen Elizabeth in 2014 and the influences of lessons learned with their associated impact on the process and planning for her sister ship.
