The MV Africa Mercy is a hospital ship run by the international charity 'Mercy Ships' that provides free medical and humanitarian services to the people of Africa. The vessel is currently the largest civil floating hospital with 6 operating theatres, an Intensive Care Unit, laboratories, x-ray, two CT scanners and hospital beds for 78 patients. Over a period of 12 months some 7000 operations will be undertaken helping some of the most underprivileged people in West Africa.
