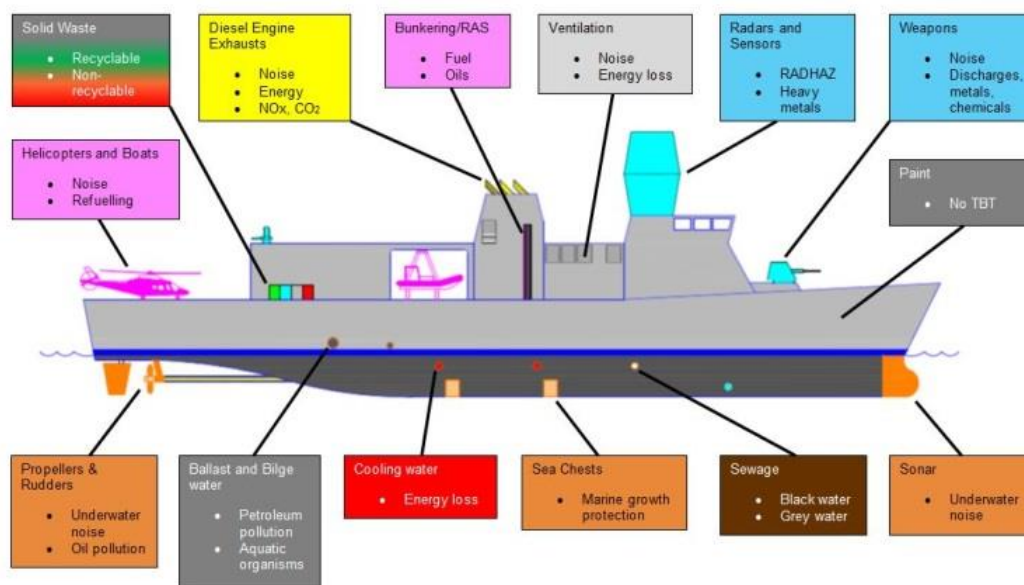

The Future Warship – Green and Mission Capable

The environment and its protection are uppermost in the public consciousness as we progress into the 21st Century. There is an increasing need for modern navies to consider environmental protection. This protection starts on the drawing board, at the very beginning of warship development.

This talk considers warship development and the opportunity to intelligently integrate environmental protection into the design, build, operation, maintenance and disposal of the modern warship. The penalties for not taking environmental protection seriously are not just subsequent physical damage, but are based in international legislation and reputational damage. The accelerating pace of change, both in the earth's climate and in legislation, is going to be an ongoing issue for warship designers. The need to focus on today's legislation and anticipate the requirements of tomorrow are at the forefront in developing through-life ship solutions.
