MSubs – Automation and Submersible

MSubs are a principal supplier of bespoke manned and unmanned underwater submersibles for both military and commercial users. They lead the world in the development of large unmanned underwater vehicles and manned, dive-lock-out submarines for use by the US DOD. Their Parent company is the US company Submergence Group LLC.

Current projects they are involved in are the Mayflower Autonomous Ship (MAS), an autonomous vessel aiming to sail across the Atlantic Ocean unmanned, following the route of the Pilgrim Fathers. The vessel will be powered by renewable energy – Wind, Solar and current.

Another major project that they are involved in is the Swimmer Delivery Vehicles programme which is one of their core revenue streams. These submersibles are designed for delivering UA Department of Defence.
