Noakes Group has recently restored the heritage-listed Rosman ferry *Radar* to full working order, including replacing the engine, re-sheathing the hull with fibreglass and bringing the vessel into AMSA Survey compliance.

Radar was built in 1947 in Berry's Bay. After a seven-year restoration and almost three quarters of a century later, *Radar* was relaunched into a very different Sydney Harbour. From the days of the first fleet, Port Jackson evolved into a working harbour known as Sydney Harbour today but its working roots are now but a glimmer of past history.

Radar's launch was a celebration of a merging of cultures: that of our pre-colonisation women's art, and that of the art of wooden-boat construction. Radar's future on the present-day Sydney Harbour lies in her past and the challenges faced by turning a profit from her existence. The ferry has a strong social connection for Sydneysiders to their once-working harbour.
