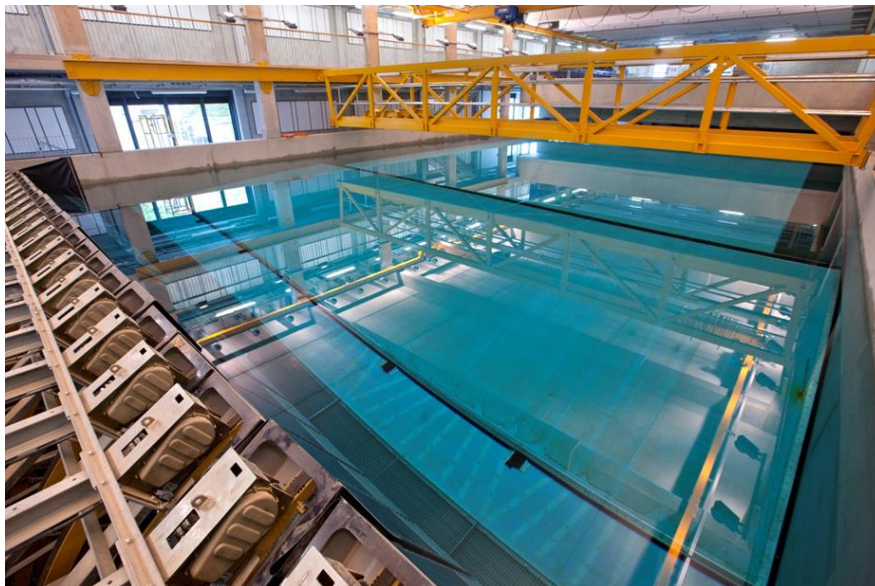

Plymouth University's COAST laboratory



Housed in Plymouth University's Marine Building, the Coastal Ocean and Sediment Transport (COAST) Laboratory supports the work of the scientist, engineers and students of the School of Marine Science and Engineering.

The laboratory houses two basins, three flumes and several hydraulic test benches. The larger of the two basins is the deep water Ocean Basin that is used for testing scale models of marine renewable energy and other moored devices. Regular waves and realistic sea states can be used to put the models through their paces in a measurable and repeatable way.
