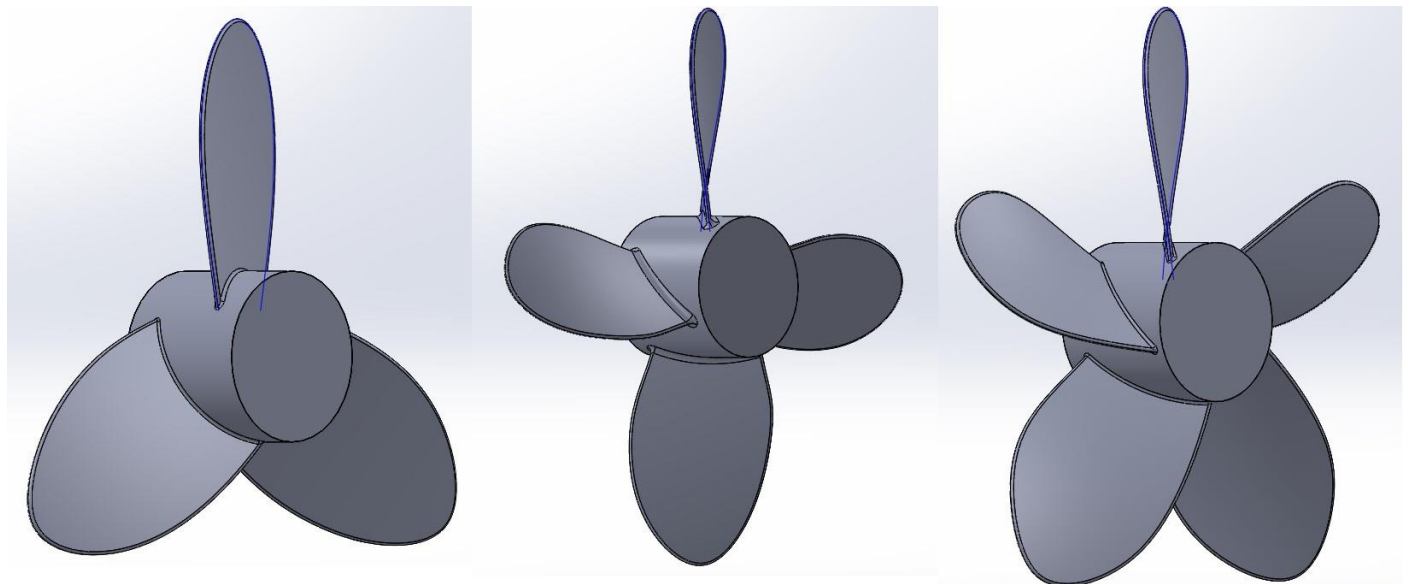
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A Presentation of Research into Air Lubrication on the hull of a ship as a drag reduction technique

Presented by Mr. David Hitchmough



Air lubrication is a promising technology that has seen continuing investigation and development over recent years. Advancement in computational resources has meant that it is now possible to carry out more advanced CFD simulations of the technology, and this has opened the opportunity for further research and development. With the improvement in resources this has raised additional questions about how to replicate the conditions and geometry in computer simulation. What is of particular interest in this area of research is determining the real-world benefit of the technology by assessing what potential detriments that may arise to the vessel's seakeeping function and propulsive efficiency, and these challenges will be discussed in this talk.
