# Yacht keel design and construction: what can we learn from the capsize of *Finistere?*

#### Abstract


Just before midnight on 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2018 the yacht *Finistere*, competing in the Bunbury and Return ocean race, suffered a catastrophic failure of its keel. This caused her to capsize and the six crew entered the water. Four of the crew were successfully rescued, however two tragically died.

This presentation will summarise the DoT (WA) technical report of the incident, followed by a structured discussion of what lessons can be learned, both by naval architects and by the broader yachting community.
