The International Maritime Organisation is now implementing their *Initial Strategy for Reduction of Greenhouse Gas Emissions from International Shipping*. This includes amendments to the MARPOL Convention to give effect to the ‘short term measure’, designed to meet the 2030 level of ambition of a 40% reduction in carbon intensity. The short-term measure provides for a combination of technical and operational changes to meet the emission-reduction requirements which will increase annually throughout this decade.

Australia, through AMSA, and other maritime administrations globally are preparing the legislative and regulatory changes required to give effect to the short-term measure from January 2023. This measure is a major step under the IMO’s decarbonisation strategy, but it is only the first step.

This presentation will provide a regulator’s perspective on what decarbonisation will mean for the maritime industry, both in the next few years and in the longer term.
