The Development of the Indian Ocean Tsunami Warning and Mitigation System 2005-2016: Achievements and Challenges.

The Indian Ocean tsunami on 26th December 2004 resulted in the loss of over 230,000 lives and the displacement of over 1.6 million people around the Indian Ocean, with estimated economic losses of \$14 billion. At the time, no tsunami warning system existed for the Indian Ocean and the catastrophe brought renewed focus on the need for a regional tsunami warning system to serve the Indian Ocean countries. Following the disaster. Intergovernmental Oceanographic Commission (IOC) of UNESCO was given a mandate by its Member States to lead the development and implementation of an Indian Ocean Tsunami Warning and Mitigation System (IOTWMS).

Tony Elliott was the Head of Secretariat for the IOTWMS for 10 years from 2006 to 2016 and was responsible for the coordination of the international efforts to develop a fully functional end-to-end Tsunami Warning System. His presentation will cover the development of the upstream warning system, from earthquake detection to warning dissemination, and the continuing efforts to improve the downstream system, from tsunami warning to safe evacuation. He will highlight the successes and achievements of the last 12 years and comment on the challenges that remain for the future. He will also emphasise the importance of continued international cooperation to improve and strengthen global tsunami warning and mitigation systems.
