Abstract

Western Australian Museum has the largest collection of historic watercraft in the Southern Hemisphere. There are 69 watercraft, distributed at museum sites in Albany, Geraldton and Fremantle. The 40 watercraft in A-Shed are a diverse collection of vessels not normally seen by the general public. They range from a pearling lugger through to the smallest dinghy and though not on display, these vessels are considered an important part of Western Australia's maritime heritage.
