HMS Courageous Tour



Have you ever wanted to go on board a nuclear submarine? H.M.S. Courageous was the last of the Churchill Class submarines. She was launched on the 7th of March 1970 and served during the Falklands war with her sister vessel HMS Conqueror. She now resides as the only nuclear museum vessel in the United Kingdom.

This is a great opportunity to look around this vessel and see what life was like on board for the 103 crew members which served on her. This will also include a guided tour of Devonport's Naval Heritage Centre where you can look through a hands-on working periscope, visit historic buildings and explore the site's galleries.

Due to the vessel being located within Her Majesty's dockyard the tour is open to UK passport holders only. Sturdy footwear is required on board the vessel. There is one ladder to climb on this tour so please ensure that you are able to undertake this.
