"An overview of Abu Dhabi Ship Building and a briefing on the Baynunah Corvette Program"

Abstract:-

Abu Dhabi Ship Building (ADSB) was conceived in the early 1990s by His Highness Sheik Mohammed bin Zayed Al Nahyan and by 1996 the vision had become a reality when ADSB was formally created as Public Shareholding Company in Abu Dhabi. In the 12 years since its inception ADSB has seen rapid and successful growth in all of its areas of operation. The presentation will describe the modern facilities that have been created at ADSB's shipyard in Musaffah which support the wide range of shipbuilding, ship refit and ship repair activities which are undertaken by the Company. The presentation will also describe the new Baynunah Class Corvette which is being built at ADSB for the UAE Navy. The Corvette Program is the first of its kind to be undertaken in the Gulf region and it will help establish ADSB as the prime builder of sophisticated military and para military vessels in the GCC region.
